We've made a couple of small buys for FWAF-2 already and it owns some terrific old Burgundies, including 1966 DRCs, some great white Burgundies—Coche-Dury Corton-Charlemagne, Domaine Leflaive Montrachet, Comtes Lafon Meursault, some classic Bordeaux, including several cases of 1982s OWC, and some great California OWCs of Screamers, Harlan, Bond, Jonata, Dominus, and Shafer Hillside Select.*

*If you are looking for a fun wine to close out the Summer with, I recommend Kitchak Cellars 2008 Scherzo Rose of Cabernet. It is a terrific summertime wine with significantly more complexity than your run-of-the-mill Rose. Refreshing and interesting, a great summertime combination!!!*
